- Assess and complete minor to moderate home modifications, including ramps, rails, and bathroom adjustments
- Collaborate with occupational therapists and participants to ensure modifications meet NDIS goals
- Provide accurate quotes, timelines, and material requirements
- Comply with building regulations, standards, and work health and safety practices
- Maintain clean and safe work environments in participant homes
- Document work completed and submit before-and-after records where required
- Use respectful communication with participants, families, and team members

Essential Requirements

- Trade qualification or proven experience in carpentry, renovations, or building works
- Australian Citizenship, Permanent Residency, or valid Working Visa
- Current NDIS Worker Screening Check
- Current Working With Children Check (WWCC) valid in Victoria
- Valid Australian driver's licence
- Own tools and vehicle (with necessary insurances)
- Strong attention to detail and commitment to safe work practices
